



# VITRECTOMY SURGERY

## Good practices in financing mechanisms of ophthalmology: experience of Poland, Czech Republic, Slovakia and Hungary



### To 2018

the financing of ophthalmic care in state and communal institutions was carried out by the method of fixed budget (estimates).

### From April 1st 2020

the financing reform was extended to secondary outpatient and inpatient care. Appropriate packages of medical guarantees were developed and implemented, which included a list of medical services and medicines.

### 2018 - April 1st 2020

the payment of primary care providers by the capitation method was introduced, the hospital and outpatient sectors, which provided specialized care, continued to be financed on the basis of a fixed budget.

### From 2020

surgical treatment of ophthalmological cases is included in the PMG package "Surgery for adults and children in hospital". Services were paid according to the global budget, taking into account adjustment factors (global rate 4563.64 UAH/≈150 EUR\*).

### From 2022

ophthalmological cases are included in the PMG package "Surgeries for adults and children in the conditions of a one-day hospital". Payment for services was carried out as a combination of the global budget and the global rate and payment for a treated case of DRG (global rate 7506 UAH/≈221 EUR\*). At the end of the year, the share ratio of DRG was 0.35.

\*Official average hryvnia exchange rate against foreign currencies according to NBU data in 2020: 1 EUR = 30.79 UAH.
